2. Transportation from/to the airport

Participants should arrive at the closest airport to Murcia, namely the Alicante airport El Altet (70 km).

A public transportation bus to Murcia downtown is available every two hours from 9 am to 9 pm (for the detailed timetable, please consult the attached timetable). The cost of the ticket is 4,5€ one way. Tickets can be purchased at the bus or in advance through the website <http://www.alsa.es/portal/site/Alsa>.

To cover arrivals outside the bus schedule, we will organise two transfers by bus on arrival on Sunday and two transfers on departure on Wednesday. To allow us to plan accurately this additional transportation schedule, please send to the Secretariat **as soon as possible** your flight details.

Finally, taxi fares range from 80 € (daily rate) to 100 € (Sunday and night rate) one way (airport → Murcia or Murcia → airport). Please note that taxi fares will be at participants' own expenses.
