The purpose of the “European Day of Risk Training” is to foster connections and dialogues between the three public authorities concerned by conducting training for the management of risks and crises, namely:

- students and other professional candidates interested in participating in such initial or continuing education
- educational structures at different levels (Masters, Specialized Masters, professional training at post-baccalaureate level)
- Businesses, Government Organizations and other bodies likely to employ auditors of such training

It provides initial training, as well as professional training.

It will deal with the theme of risk in the large sense: a global approach to risk management, training on risks that are industrial, natural, financial, and insurance-related, training on business crises, on territorial risk management, on safety and security, etc.

It will be a forum for:

- presenting books, studies, films, DVDs, etc. on risks, launching the 1st edition of the Risk Analysis Festival,
- presenting Dissertations and organizing an Exchange of Dissertations allowing authors of Dissertations to find Government Organizations, Businesses with which to apply their proposed ideas,
- facilitating internship research
- presenting the needs of employers via recruitment material

It will also allow partnerships to develop among European educational bodies.
