Founded in the early 80's, has been transformed in "institute", as a reward of the high scientific and technological level reached through the collaboration with CNR, APAT, Aeronautics Meteorological Service, Hydrographic and Mareographical National Service.

Is the city level of the "Civil Protection System", which is distributed along all levels of government of the State.
