

PASI Workshop Funding Application

The University at Buffalo is pleased to provide funding for participation in the PASI workshop: Applying Computational Models to Real-Case Scenarios for Volcanic Hazard Assessment, to be held at the University of Colima, in Colima, Mexico, in January of 2013. This funding is supported by the National Science Foundation, and will be available to eligible applicants chosen by a participation selection committee of three suitably qualified individuals.

Awardees will receive a flat amount to cover their flights to and from the workshop, as well as additional subsistence costs for food and lodging during the workshop. Airfare funding will be awarded based on the price of comparable flights from the applicant's city and country of departure. Flights will be booked through the University's travel agency, and will be chosen based on the most cost-efficient flights available for the dates requested. **Awardees must fly on a U.S. carrier to in order to be covered, and will be responsible for any costs above the amount awarded.** Recipients will be notified of their awards by Thursday, November 15th, and will receive further instructions on booking their flights at that time.

The selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Relevance to the research or work directly undertaken by the applicant
- Potential for significant long-term impact in the participants' field of work, as well as the broader implications of that work
- Academic and/or professional merit
- NSF regulations requiring 50% of all participants come from U.S. institutions, with a high regard to gender, age, and ethnicity diversity
