<b>Session Objectives</b>	<p>This preparatory meeting of Mayors, Local Governments and Partners of the Making Cities Resilient Campaign aims gather all the city representatives and friends in advance of the Global Platform, to share and consult on the priorities for enhanced implementation of HFA at local level, while at the same time establish the needs for the Post 2015 framework (HFA 2).</p> <p>To ensure that implementation of DRR at Urban and Local level is prioritized UNISDR with partners launched the Making Cities Resilient campaign in 2010. By April 2013, more than 1,400 cities and local governments have “signed up” to the Campaign, and more than 40 global partner organizations have pledged their cooperation. Regionally and locally there are many more organizations applying and promoting the Campaign tools and principles with many partners implementing programmes and developing additional tools. The overall impact of the Campaign to date has created increased expectations and demand from participating and new Cities/Local Governments to access more information on disaster risk, technical cooperation, and support to implement the core principles of making cities resilient as set out in the Ten Essentials.</p> <p>This preparatory meeting will focus on (a) Progress of Making Cities Resilient Campaign (b) Outcomes of the Local HFA reports and (c) Recommendation for the Post-HFA including discussion on the city statement/action plan to be presented at the closing session of the Global Platform.</p> <p>A drafting group will be established for finalizing the Draft Statement/Action Plan and key messages along with speakers would be identified to ensure participation at the Informal Plenary for HFA 2.</p>
