





































Introducing 7th INDM Conference

Seventh International Conference on Integrated Natural Disaster Management will be held while notable flood fatalities and loss of Iranian citizens in Hajj Incident highlights the need to change existing crisis management methods. On one hand, earthquakes and floods and other climate changes and symptoms such as droughts, floods and other situations are uncontrollable events, which threaten the lives and welfare of the citizens. On the other hand, constructions in rivers range and on the faults are other issues which increase the loss and consequences of natural disasters.

Over last 40-50 years, ignoring construction rules and paying determined fines instead, has led to the non-resistant buildings to earthquake and floods and as a result, the vulnerability of our society made a leap forward and unlike many countries, such as Japan, rather than sustainable development, unsustainable and unbalanced development are wasting financial resources. In a precise view point, a defective cycle in terms of construction could be found that is wasting financial resources and increasing society vulnerability.

A critical question here is that how long this defective cycle may continue working and what losses it will impose, and how could it be reformed and put in its proper circuit? The role of the experts, which by the preparation and amendment of the national disaster management regulations can assume a significant role in the adjustment of the current approach, is obvious, but issues such as permanent and beneficial upgrade in stakeholders knowledge at any level, manufacturing and use of optimized materials and above all, a comprehensive approach to risk management with an emphasis on the implementation of the Sendai operational document to reduce the risk of crisis in the next fifteen years should not be neglected, since they can lead us toward improvements to a more resilient society.

The seventh conference aims to invite Iranian and global professors, in order to transfer knowledge to the country for eliminating challenges and improving current situation, and in this concern, fulfill its cultural mission. Experts, scholars, specialists and students are respectfully welcomed to participate in the 7th conference.

Call for Abstracts

The conference requires a copy of your abstract (s) which are related to the conferences topics and themes. Papers should be limited to one page, typed single – spaced, paper size A4 (210x297mm) including the title of the paper, authors full name, mailing address and email or fax number.

Papers should be written in either English or Persian and must be original and not presented in any other conferences or published in any journals before. They also should not be translations. All abstracts should be submitted to the conference secretariat via. www.indm.org

Deadline for Abstract Submission:

Abstracts must be submitted to the conference secretariat by 5th Jan 2016, via www.indm.ir

Deadline for Final Paper submission:

Those papers approved to be presented as oral presentations or as posters will be informed to the authors via email by 8th of January 2016.

Consequently, the final version of the paper should be submitted to the conference secretariat by 25st of January 2016. The authors will be informed of the paper preparation guidelines after they receive the final approval of their papers.

Oral Presentations:

A maximum of 20% of the papers will be presented orally and the rest will be displayed in the form of posters.

If papers are to be presented by a group (max 2 people) the first author's registration fee will be waived and the second author will receive a 50% discount. The conference certificate will only be awarded to the presenter of the paper.

Poster Presentations:

Papers accepted to be presented as a poster will be allocated with an appropriate display space.

The poster presenter's registration fee will be waived and he/she will be awarded with a conference certificate.

Workshops

Within the two days of INDM Conference, a set of additional activities are running, such as technical seminars and practical workshops which will be organized by various Iranian and international experts and organization. More information on the workshops will be announced in the "Final Program" of the conference.

Language of the Conference

The official languages of the conference will be both Farsi and English.

Certificate

Each participant will be given a certificate for participation in the conference. This certificate only will be issued to those participants who have attended most of the conference sessions.
