

Ninth National Earthquake and Safety Drill in Iranian Schools

In order to create a deeper understanding of the safety culture at schools, Public Education Department of International Institute of Earthquake and Engineering, IIEES will organize the Ninth National Drill in November 29, 2007. This drill which has been started since 1966 (2 years as pilot study) will cover 14.5 million students in more than 124,000 schools. All students in Iran by hearing Earthquake Safety Alarm seconds through national and local radios will perform earthquake drill.

The Safety Drill program has been developed by Public Education Department of IIEES, with the cooperation of Ministry of Education, Ministry of Interior (National Committee for National Reduction), the Iranian Red Crescent Society, and Iran National Television and Radio.
