Call to Action: Safer Homes for Safer Communities
“Ligtas na Tahanan Tungo sa Matatag na Pamilya at Komunidad”

#2 Protect and promote the rights of internally displaced persons (IDPs)

- Protect the IDPs through the passage and implementation of the IDP Bill
- Ensure genuine participation of IDPs in all phases of displacement particularly in seeking durable solution.
- Address the root cause and strengthen peacebuilding mechanisms to avoid armed conflict
- Protect the rights of the vulnerable communities in areas of armed conflict, upholding the rights and dignity of the communities displaced by armed conflict
- Ensure that the temporary shelters observe BP 344 (Accessibility Law)
- Uphold the rights and dignity of IDPs inside the temporary shelters
- Uphold meaningful participation for the most at-risk group (older persons, children, women, and persons with disability) in the relocation processes
- Observe Sphere Standards for IDPs temporary shelter and relocation sites

#6 Reduce vulnerability of communities to disasters by investing in disaster preparedness, prevention and mitigation, and sustainable livelihood:

- Ensure the rights of the vulnerable communities in four thematic areas of DRRM
 - Enhance family preparedness measures
 - Put in place enabling mechanisms to support vulnerable communities for safer and durable settlements and homes
 - Strengthen collaboration among various stakeholders in implementing housing solutions for vulnerable communities
- Encourage the participation of private sectors in protecting the environment as part of resilience-building initiatives
- Promote sustainable and adaptive livelihood programs through risk transfer mechanisms
- Increase access to local funds for family preparedness
- Ensure participation of communities in housing and resettlement processes
- Mainstream schools’ DRRM plans into the local DRRM plans
- Integrate Ecosystem Management and Restoration (EMR) in DRR-CCA plans
- Strengthen the involvement of State environment agencies in resilience building

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
