

DEVELOPMENT PATTERNS ALONG THE COAST















- Lack of or insufficient documented data to inform processes
- 2. Lack of Resources to support implementation programmes, projects and activities
- 3. Leadership & Ownership
- 4. Having a Plan does not mainstream CDRM
- 5. Translating Mainstreaming to targeted practical approaches to reduce risk and strengthen response capabilities

- 6. Shrinking Budgets DRR & Sectors
- 7. Shrinking & Regionalize DRR Funding
- 8. DRM Systems and structures must be sustainable, functional and accessible
- Need for more detailed HVRAs National, Parish & Community levels
- 10. Need more systematic and inclusive approach to building a culture of resilience/safety/Preparedness


