ABTRACT & PAPER SUBMISSIONS

Prospective presenters in AIWEST-DR are invited to submit their abstracts that consist of **not less than** 1000 words with title and affiliation and five keywords following the abstract. The papers to be presented in this conference must have not been presented, accepted or published elsewhere. The abstract should be submitted before May 23, 2018 and the full paper should be uploaded before August 1, 2018.All submitted papers will be subjected to a review process. The abstract should explain brief background of the paper, objectives, methods, and important findings. The template of the extended abstract and full paper can be found in the Submission & Registration page and the submission can be done through the same menu.
