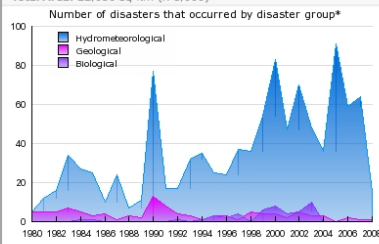

HFA Monitor is available in English, Spanish and French.

Description

The Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA) Monitoring and Progress Review process will facilitate monitoring, evaluating and reporting on the implementation of disaster risk reduction measures at the national, regional and global levels.


Objective

Capture key trends and areas of progress and challenges at all levels with regard to achieving the strategic goals of the HFA.

Benefits

Developing benchmarks and indicators that monitor, evaluate and report on progress in implementation of disaster risk reduction measures have evident benefits at the local, national, regional and global level:

- Identification of existing problems/ gaps and increasing their importance on the political agenda
- Promoting solutions through new or strengthened policies, programmes, plans, capacities and resources
- Developing systematic, comprehensive data and information management systems with regard to disaster reduction
- Establishing generic standards for implementing disaster risk reduction actions at all levels

Description

'HFA Monitor' is the ISDR system's online tool to monitor, review and report on progress and challenges in the implementation of disaster risk reduction and recovery actions at the national level, in accordance with the Hyogo Framework's priorities.

The tool has been designed and coordinated by the ISDR secretariat and will be hosted on Prevention Web. Inputs to the online tool will lead to the generation of comprehensive National Progress Reviews for the period 2007-09, and will give countries easy access to its disaster risk information and monitoring trends in progress over the years.

Stakeholder accessibility

Designated national authority/ HFA focal points will have access to the HFA Monitor online tool from May 2008 onwards. Focal points will receive an email notification with a user id and password from the ISDR secretariat in late April 2008 to enable access to the online tool in May via PreventionWeb country pages.

Sample template

When working online is inconvenient, you may download a Microsoft Word 'HFA Monitor' sample template from the 'Key documents' section of your country page via PreventionWeb.

The sample template replicates, to the extent possible, the online HFA Monitor tool. Please download it and familiarize yourself with the requirements in advance of accessing the HFA Monitor online tool in May 2008.

The HFA Monitor templates will be available to download from PreventionWeb in 5 languages – English, Spanish, French, Arabic and Russian.

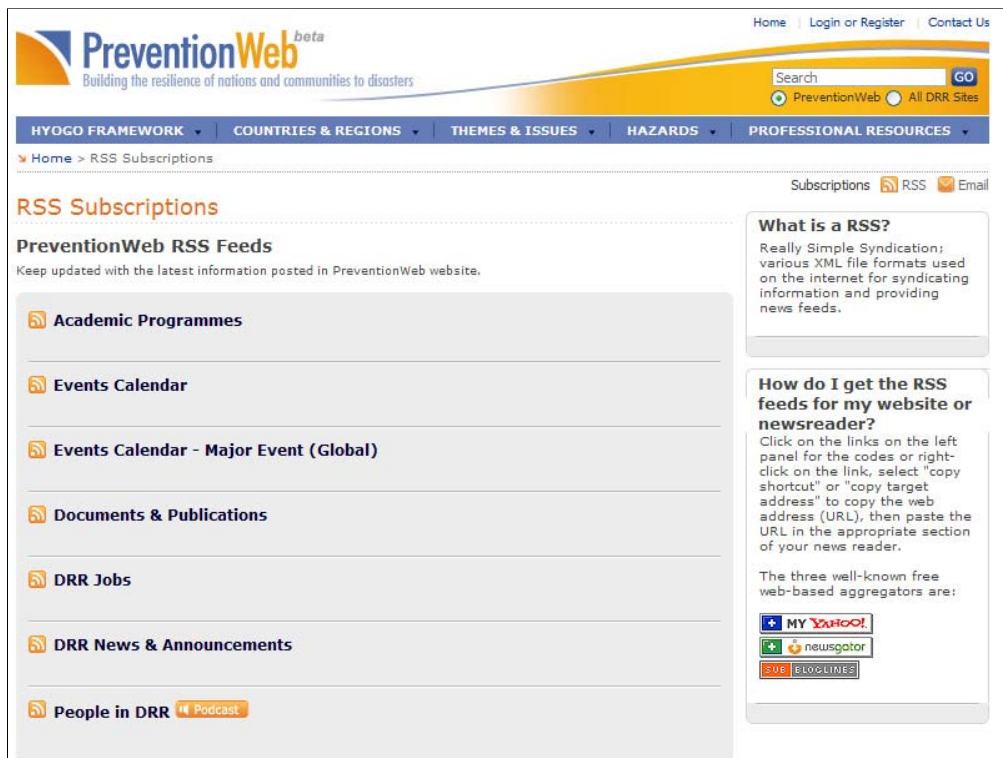

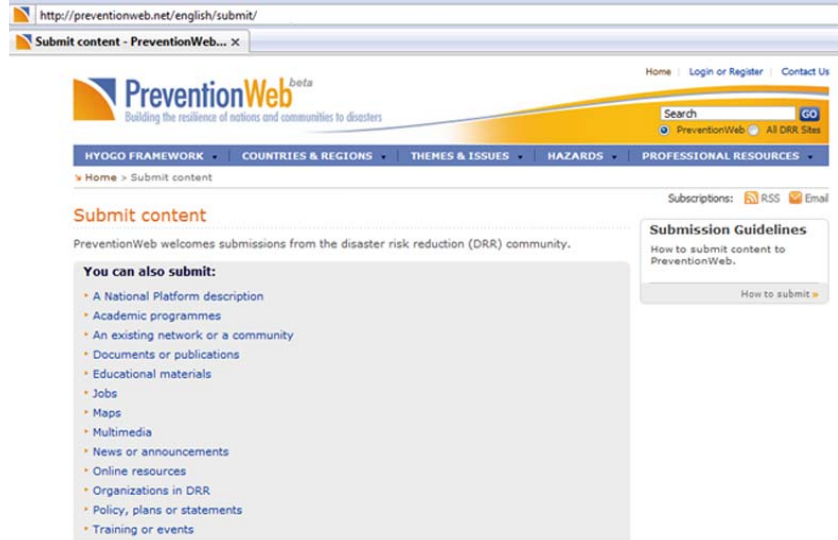
