

Trend of Natural Disasters in Mozambique (1950 – 2009) INGC, 2009



from 2000 to 2013



FLOODS in 2000: over 700 dead, one million affected people, 600,000 displaced, extensive infrastructure damage. 2013: 119 reported dead, 420,000 people were affected 241,000 people displaced.



DROUGHTS: in 2002 affected about 600,000 people in 38 districts; most recent drought in 2009 affected 500,000 people in 17 districts




CYCLONES: Delphina in 2002 caused 50 deaths;

Jokwe in 2008: 13 deaths

Key actions

- Mozambique endorsed Hyogo Framework for Action and African Strategy for DRR
- New structures for disaster risk management coordination & multisectoral actions: (INGC- CTGC-Partners)
- DM Law & National Master Plan for Disaster
 Management responding to HFA and contributing to MDGs
- Contingency plan: allocation of Government funds common annual plan- joint simulations
- EW systems in place & Local Risk Management
 Committees (CLGR) formed




Emergency coordination mechanisms between GoM & HCT


