3. Action is more effective and imaginative when children and young people are involved.

4. Reducing risk must involve all levels and sectors of government.

Everyone, in all sectors, in particular the education sector, have a valuable role in DRR. Including children in local decision making is key for effective DRR. Good development *is* good risk management.
