HYOGO FRAMEWORK

1. Ensure that Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) is a national and local priority with strong institutional basis for implementation
2. Identify, assess and monitoring risk and enhance early warning
3. Use knowledge, innovation and education to build a culture of safety and resilience at all levels
4. Reduce the underlying risk factors (reduce risk in key sectors)
5. Strengthen disaster preparedness for effective response at all levels

1. Governance - Organisational, Institutional, Policy and Decision-Making Framework
2. Knowledge, Information, Public Awareness and Education
3. Analysis And Evaluation Of Hazards, Vulnerabilities And Elements At Risk
