Need and Challenges for Urban Risk Reduction (URR)

- Increase in population and urbanisation
- Unsustained development
- Poor application of urban development tools and instruments
- Increasing natural hazards and implication on triggering manmade hazards
- Inadequate awareness and capacity of local government
- Absence on URR in local planning and project implementation

- Capacity Building in Asia Using Information Technology Application (CASITA)



Role of ADPC as regional institution in mitigating urban risk

- Capacity Building
- Pilot project including mitigation and preparedness
- Documentation
- Advocacy
- Supporting Networks of city Governments and National technical and training Institutions





Role of ADPC as regional institution in mitigating urban risk: (Capacity Building)

- **Target groups** : Municipal authorities, Academics, school authorities, emergency responders, development agencies.
 - Creating awareness for establishing techno-legal regime in urban community
 - Regional courses on UDMP, EVRC, FDRM, MDRRG etc
 - Advocacy for enforcement of Bye-laws, building permits, LUP, following construction code norms
 - Roles and responsibilities of stakeholders involved in Urban development and mainstreaming
 - Partnering with national training Institutions

- Contingency planning for UDRR
- Community demonstration projects for multi hazards environment
- Technology transfer for URR

- Urban Task Force in URR









Emerging needs for URR intervention

- Hazard and vulnerability mapping
- Capacity building at local level
- Strict enforcement of Building bye laws, building permission and LUP
- Stocktaking of urban vulnerable built infrastructure
- Advocacy for legal framework for UDRR
- Information, knowledge management for best practices for URM
- Mainstreaming DRR in local governance









Approaches for Global campaign on URR

" ADPC is promoting campaign for regional urban risk reduction for last 15 years by advocacy, demonstration and capacity building through networking and collaboration"

- Strong networking of technical, city leagues and cities for URR
- Extensive knowledge sharing and dissemination on DRR
- Demonstrative URR projects for sensitising urban local bodies and community
- Launching projects for multi country-multi city partnership for URR
- Advocating and Accelerating mainstreaming URR in Local development
