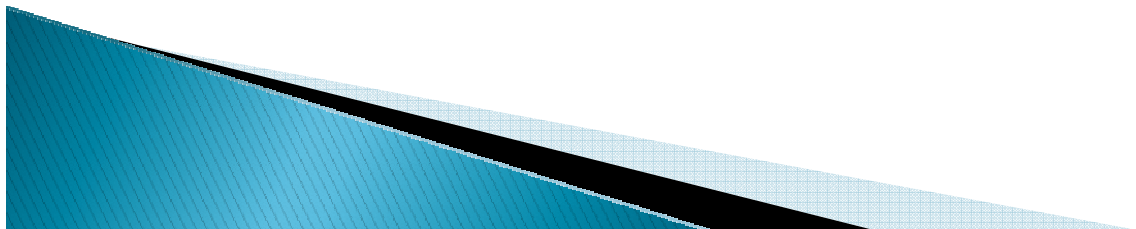

Trigger Events: Typhoons Ketsana (Ondoy) and Parma (Pepeng)

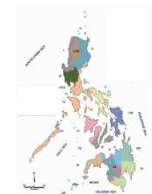


Crafting the PDNA

100+ representatives, 18 government line agencies,
leagues of local government units, WB, ADB, UN

Coverage: impact on 13 key sectors of the economy, local
governance, social protection, finance, and DRM

Method: analysis on damage and losses and on the
economic and social impact, including those suffered
by the private sector



Results of PDNA

- ▶ \$4.4 billion needed for recovery and reconstruction for three years

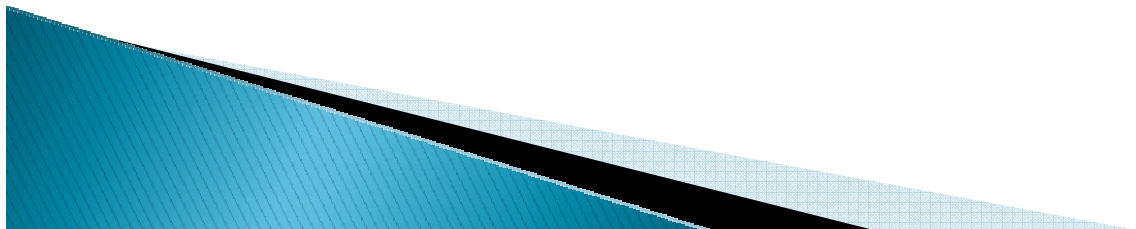
- ▶ Identified key areas for intervention:
 - Rural production
 - Flood management
 - housing
 - DRRM
 - Local governance

- ▶ Role of private sector



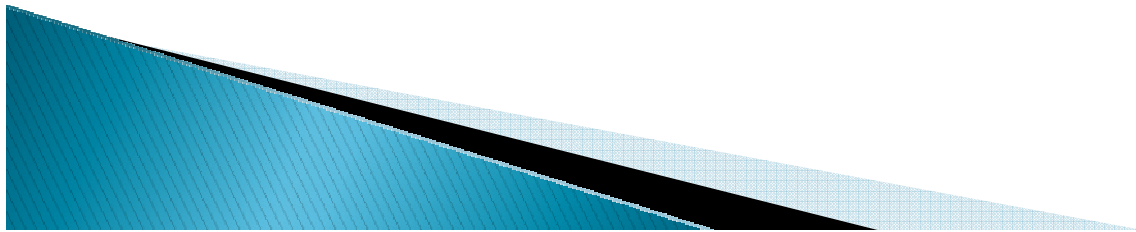
Policies and programs arising from PDNA

- ▶ Formulation of the Reconstruction Management Plan
- ▶ Reconstruction Monitoring and Evaluation System (RMES)
- ▶ Prioritization of projects

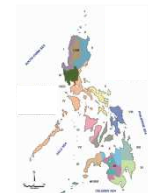

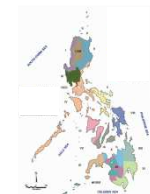

Tree Nursery Launch kicks off Marikina watershed reforestation

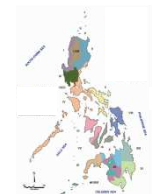

Other gains from the PDNA

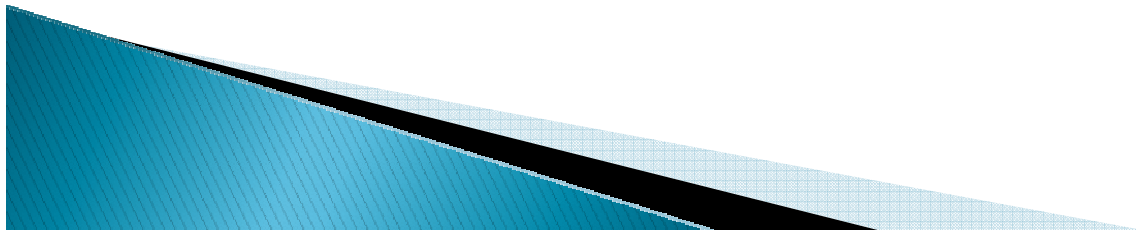
- ▶ Indicative Reconstruction Expenditure Plan, which explores budget realignments to fund reconstruction efforts
- ▶ As of March 2010, facilitated the release of ₱8.6 billion to various agencies and LGUs to jump-start recovery and reconstruction efforts
- ▶ Emergency employment and conditional cash aid to food hit areas
- ▶ Fast tracked passage of DRRM Law

Challenges and Recommendations

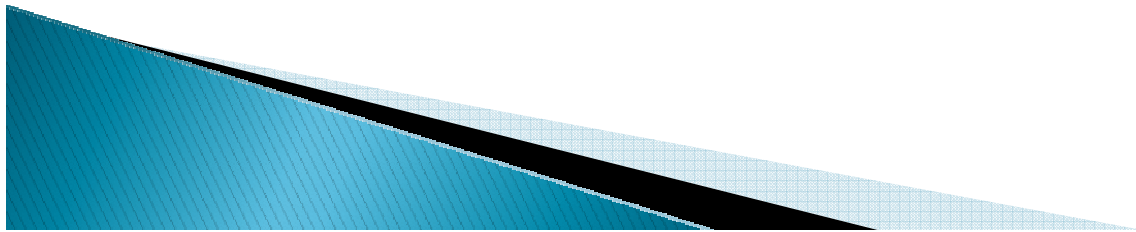
INTEGRATING DRR priorities in planning, programming, decision-making processes in the context of DRRM Law, CCA Law, mainstreaming framework
