The Kyrgyz Republic



Total area of the country is 198,8 thousand square kilometers. 98% of the territory is located at 1000 meter above the sea level.

Out of 70 varieties of dangerous natural disaster common in the world, almost all are frequent in the Kyrgyz Republic (except for volcanoes, tsunamis, typhoons).

Emergency Situation Statistics in 15 years

Number of Emergency Situation	Number of people dead	Amount in damage in USD
Approximately 2500	Over 1000	Approximately 500 million



Damage from emergency situations

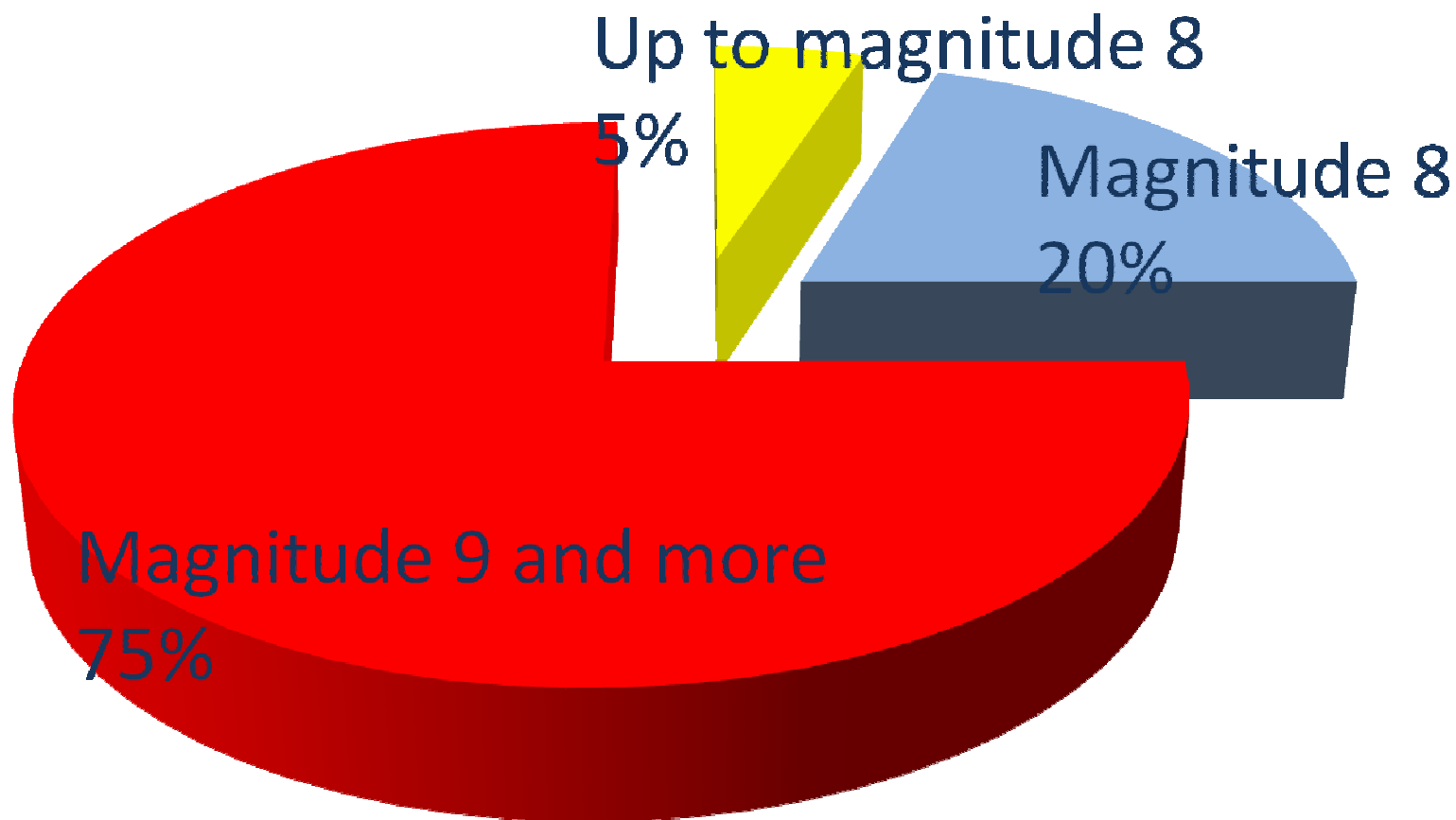


Budgetary financing for disaster prevention and liquidation is approximately **6 million USD**

Annual direct damage from emergency situations
30 – 35 million USD

Financial and material damage in emergency situations exceeds the real capacity of the civil defense system **5 times.**

Major Problems



1. Absence of the National Strategy on disaster risk reduction;
2. Shortcomings of the legislative base;
3. Weak financial, material and technical capacity;
4. Insufficient level of knowledge and education in disaster risk reduction;
6. Insufficiency of the information advocacy and raising awareness processes;
7. Insufficient level of scientific research and analytical capacity;
1. Shortcomings in the monitoring and prognosis systems;
2. Insufficient level of equipment of the fire and rescue divisions;



Thresholds achieved



In accordance with the 5 priorities of the Hyogo Framework for Action, the Kyrgyz Government with the support of the European Commission, UNDP Kyrgyzstan and other donors are implementing the following actions:

- Development of the National Platform for disaster risk reduction and designing the National Strategy for disaster risk management;
- Enhancing the preparedness of the population to disasters and emergency situations ;
- Improvement of the monitoring , evaluation and early warning systems;
- Cooperation on various levels for disaster risk reduction;

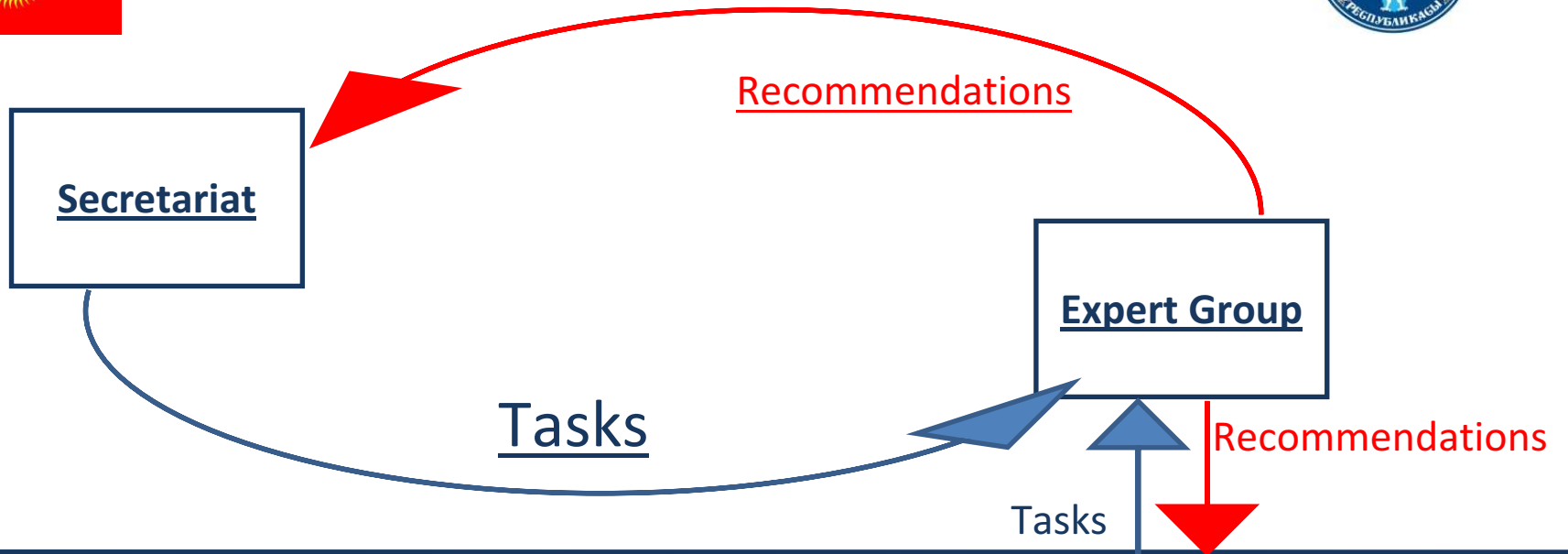

Outcomes of establishing the National Platform



1. Development of the National Strategy of the Kyrgyz Republic to ensure integrating security of the population and territories of the Kyrgyz Republic in emergency and crises situations over the period 2011-2015; development and enhancement of the legislative base;
2. Development of various disaster monitoring and prognosis systems; Early warning is more accounted;
3. Enhancement of the unified system of information advocacy in the field of civil defense and raising awareness among the population on actions in emergency situation;
4. Disaster prevention event occur regularly;
5. Procession of development and equipment of the rescue forces. Development of international cooperation in reaction to emergency situation;



Main objectives of the National Platform



Establishment of an effective mechanism on disaster risk management. Development and integration of the programme targeted activities in disaster risk reduction into the development strategy of the country. Elevation of the security level of the population and territories with the objective to provide sustainable development of the state and the society.
