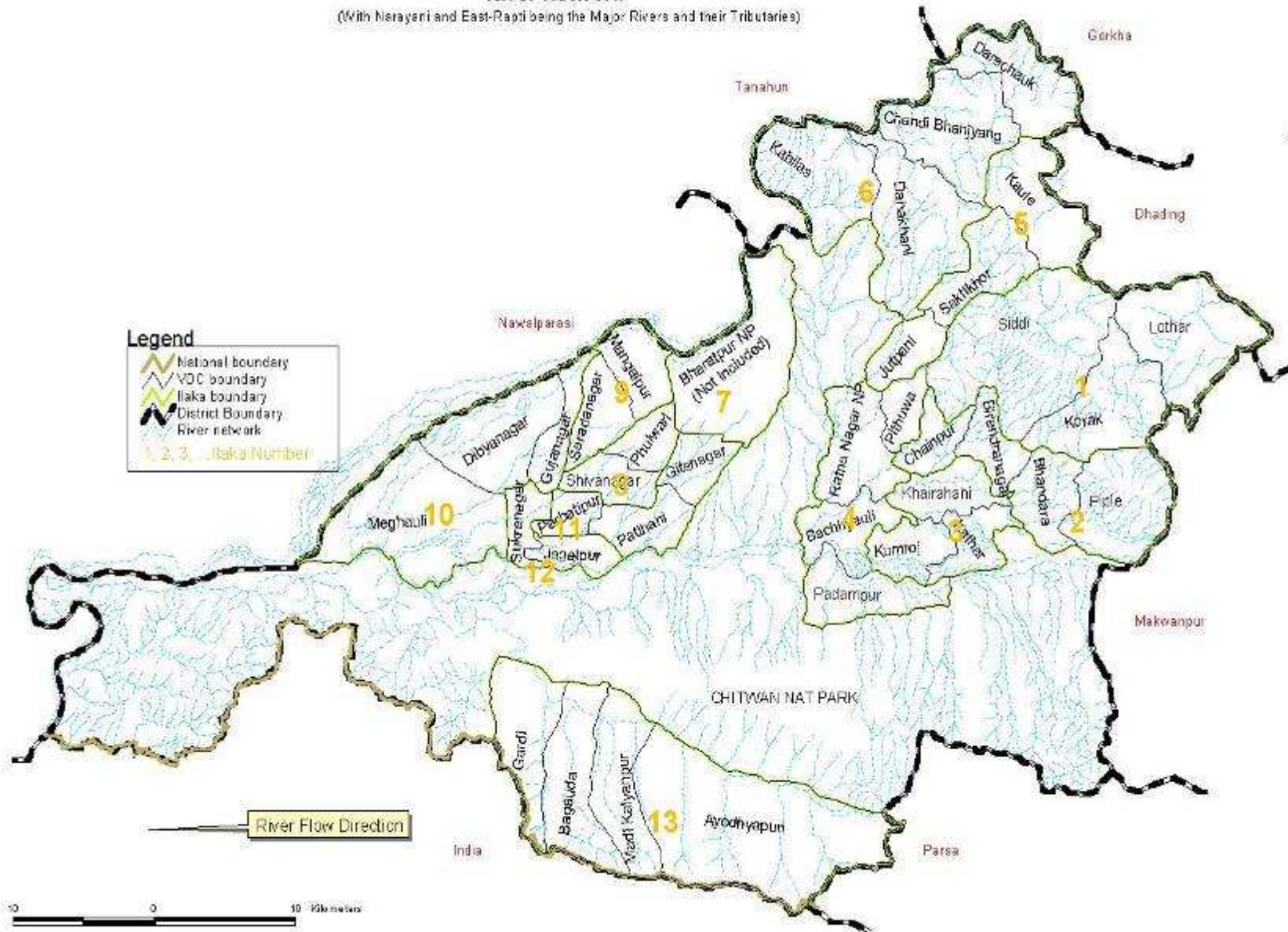
Vulnerabilities and Disaster Risks

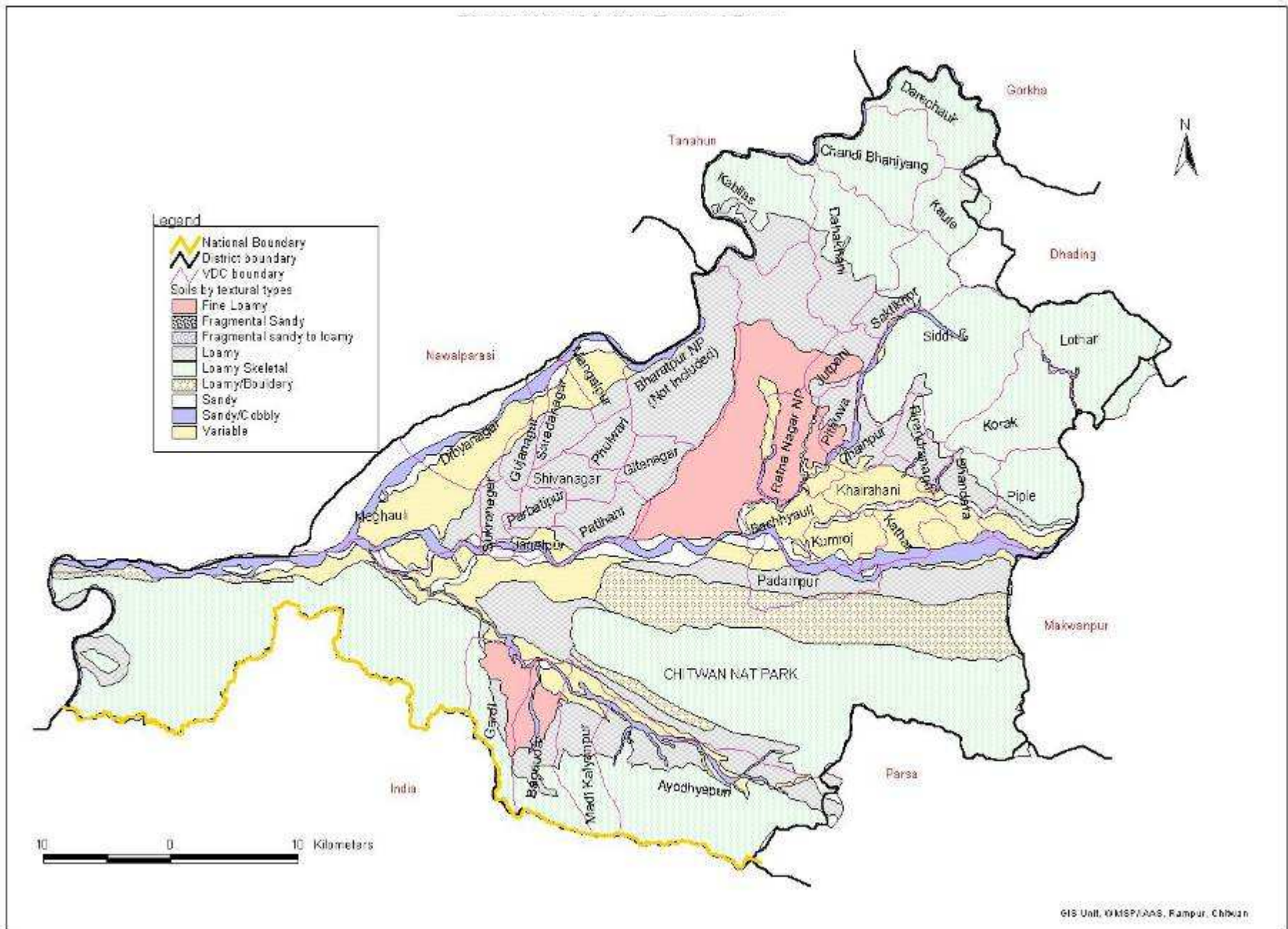
- Geographically, the district covers hilly region and inner Terai (plain region): 9 VDCs - hill, 27 VDCs and 2 Municipalities - inner terai
- Two major rivers: Narayani and Rapti, and other smaller streams create risk of flood in the downstream villages and landslide in the upstream villages – monsoon season
- Drought prevails during November to May
- Wildlife intrusion to farmers' field from National Park – round the year
- Forest fire during dry season – affect villages near forests

DRR and Development Activities

- District has prepared
 - District disaster management action plan, 2004
 - Community based Disaster Management Plan of 31 VDCs and 1 Municipality, 2008
- DDC allocates budget for disaster risk reduction activities (Structural and non-structural)
- DDC is secretariat to District Disaster Management Committee
- Organize pre-monsoon disaster preparedness workshops
- Implements regular activities like irrigation schemes, road, bridge/culverts construction, hospital support – part of DRR and Development



DRR and Development Activities

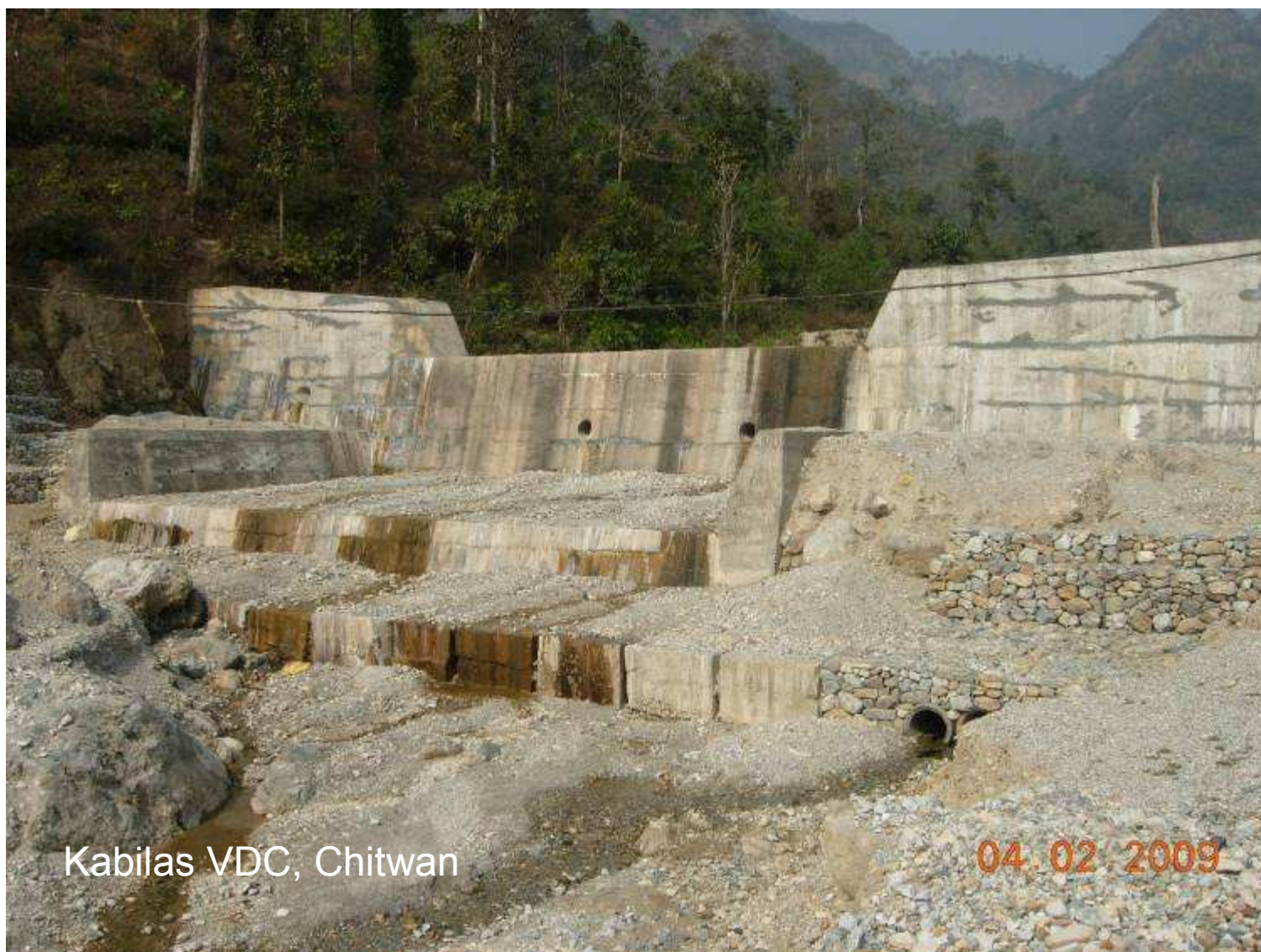
- Temporary shelters identified in flood prone VDCs
- DDC is on the way to make the district Open-Defecation-Free district
- Coordinate with Redcross and allocate budget for school disaster management program for children and teacher
- Work closely with line agencies like District Forest Office, Agriculture Development Office, Water and sanitation, Soil Conservation Office etc.
- Disaster Management Committee (DMC) formed and active in 14 VDCs



DRR and Development Activities

- Early warning communication system established in the district
- Regular trainings to VDC secretaries and other official staffs
- Provision of Disaster Focal Person in DDC
- Support for construction of check dams, river training, flood control dams, Gabion boxes etc.
- Alternate income Generation Activities for vulnerable families
- Joint DRR activities implementation with Development Organizations (INGOs)

Things to remember during and before Disaster

- Listen to the news related to weather very carefully in Radio and Television
- Identify the safest way to evacuate to temporary shelter during flood
- Immediately communicate downstream community and Police when the water level reaches to danger level
- Call flood gauge station and get the information on water level before going to bed every night during monsoon
- Form Disaster Management Committee and Volunteer groups for Early Warning and Rescue management in the community
- Give priority to pregnant, old people, disable people, diseased and children while performing rescue operation in flooded areas.
