The Hydro-geological Risk is high in Colobraro: landslides regularly occur in close proximity of the urban area during the rain season. In 2010 a landslide blocked the only access road to the village, which seats at the very top of the hill, precipitous falls surrounding it on three sides: the Hydro geological survey of the river basin	

regional authority classify parts of the urban area as R4 (highest) and 3 (high). Seismic risk is at level 2, the second highest of four risk levels. Asperity of the territory and difficult access in rural area make summer wildfires very dangerous and destructive.

Progress and achievements – Interventions have been realized in order to defend and consolidate the urban area against land slides. Rural roads are regularly cleared for easy access in case of fire	
Plans – We need to focus our resources toward reducing our hydrogeological risks	
Essential 5 – Safe schools and health facilities	Status - 3
Progress and achievements – The only school building, in Via Lotta dei Contadini, resulted at norms in case of seismic events	
Plans – We need to collect funds in order to bring the annexed school gym up to norm .	
Essential 6 – Risk-compliant building regulation and land use applied	Status - 2
Progress and achievements – The New City Planning has been submitted for approval at the regional office and it includes the Civil emergency plan	
Plans – Revision of the urban construction norms and plan

Progress and achievements – Increase in time of the number of civil defense volunteers and improvement of adequate equipment (one 4 wheel fire truck that can also operate to remove snow in winter) stands upon a
