It seats on sand stones largely covered by Mediterranean bush and woods: it is the second municipality for extension of vegetated territory in the region. Surrounded by two affluent of the Bradano river, Tolve offers views of great beauty.

Major Disaster Risks (Please indicate major disasters that have occurred, prevailing hazards and vulnerable conditions.)	

/The entire territory is classified as level 2 on the Italian seismic risk scale 1 to 4, being 1 the highest risk level. Hydro-geologic risk: parts of the urban center are classified at level 3 and 4 on a hydro-geologic risk scale of 1 to 4 where, this time, 4 is the highest level. Recurrent land slide motions invest connecting roads. This year flooding occurred on three occasions and the last one of them, the 25th of May 2011, caused the collapse of two bridges with major disruptions in the road connection system. As woods and vegetation cover extensively the municipal territory we suffer regularly summer wild fires with extensive loss of wood resources.

They are also operative in infrastructure maintenance and hydro-geologic emergencies. They are prepared to intervene on seismic emergencies.

Progress and achievements – Financing is obtained through specific channels in case of natural disaster. The 1980 earthquake damages have been repaired with such funds. The primary school building repair will soon be completed so that the structure will be available again for school children. Financing obtained for Hydro-geologic risk will be used for interventions on some of the city areas at risk	
Plans – Completion of the public building upgrade according to seismic regulations.

Progress and achievements – The Civil Defence Plan is part of the Urban Regulation Plan under approval.

Progress and achievements – Scarcity of available financing interferes with a through planning of infrastructural upgrades. Our priorities are urban areas at risk and major lines of traffic and connection.
