RE: CONFIRMATION TO THE PARTICIPATION CAMPAIGN

The Nadi Town Council in the Republic of the Fiji Islands confirms its participation and as a partner to the World Disaster Reduction Campaign.

The Nadi Town Council will be working closely with the Department of Land and Water Resource Management, a department under the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Commissioner Western Office and the District Officer Nadi.
