Location (short description)	The town is situated on the coast ther Riviera delle Palme, in the northern Italy, facing on Thirrenian sea. The historic center of Spotorno keeps the old system of a typical Ligurian fishing village, with a linear development path on the edge of the coast, however, even if some parts were modified to exploit tourism as the promenade (including public gardens and touristic beach structures located along two kilometers of sandy coastline). Another factor related to the exploitation of tourism holiday has been building over the last decades of the twentieth century, large volumes of new buildings with the consequent expansion of new urban center in the plane of the inlet and adjacent hills.

Essential 1 – Risk reducing organization and coordination in place	Status - 2
Progress and achievements - When an emergency occurs, or when the Municipality are alerted by the Regional Civil Protection Department, there's a calling up for the meeting of Municipal Civil Protection Committee, formed by representatives of local team of "forest fire" fire brigades volunteers, White Cross (local medical first response team), Local Police and Municipal Alderman for Environment and Civil Protection with his Head Officer. The committee decides first response operations, and coordinates operations and resources as well as supplying additional expertise through various other state government bodies.	
Plans – The Municipality is planning to establish correct operative procedures for each of the hazard types, with local and national authorities, and improve communications between local Civil Protection Committee and citizens	
Essential 2 – Budget assigned	Status - 2
Progress and achievements - At national level budget is assigned for organisation disaster reduction measure such as equipment for voluntary emergency response services, and for the local teams of National Department of "Fire Brigades and Public assistance"	
Plans - Due to the big amount of money needed for an important infrastructural disaster reduction campaign, the Municipality is planning to apply for National or European funds to be invested at Municipal level.	
Essential 3 – Risk assessment prepared	Status - 2
Progress and achievements - At national level, the Department of Civil Protection, in collaboration with provincial administrations and Regional Civil Protection Offices produces map of risk for each kind of Hazard (floods, forest fires, landslides). Locally these map are discussed and confirmed (or modified) by the Province or Municipal offices

Essential 4 – Investment in risk reducing infrastructure	Status - 1
Progress and achievements - Only spot - kind investment are made by the national authority, mainly after a disaster has occurred. We know the hazards we have to face with and what damage to expect, but locally we have no money to invest in risk reduction infrastructure.

Progress and achievements – The national law for building requires the emergency plan for all sensitive infrastructure (schools, nursing homes, etc)
